#### Introduction:

The Association is a company limited by guarantee and the Objects of the Association are:

- b) to arrange and manage the recruitment, training, registration, grading and accreditation of road race course measurers in the UK;
- to regulate the delivery of an effective system of course measurement by accredited course measurers for the benefit of road race organisers and competitors in the UK;
- d) to foster and promote road race course measurement in the UK;
- e) to liaise with and advise the appropriate governing bodies, road race organisers and competitors.

# Treasurer's Report for the year ended 30th September 2023

You will know that the association treasurer sadly passed away in April after a short illness and he will be hugely missed by all who knew him. I didn't know him for very long but I valued him as a friend and also as an efficient and dependable servant to the AUKCM. Each year, at the beginning of October, he sent me the bank transactions to enable me to prepare the statutory accounts and everything else just happened quietly in the background.

Since Ken's death, it has proved very difficult to gain access to the Nat West bank accounts but I can now make payments and monitor receipts. Mike Burns has graciously picked up the job of invoicing the home countries for measurements carried out and we are in the process of chasing up outstanding payments from WA and EA.

We now have a volunteer to take over the reins and I hope to hand things over shortly after the AGM.

#### Accounts for the y/e 30-Sep-2023

Total income from measurements for the year was £4,269 of which £3,393 remained unpaid at the end of September and £2,340 unpaid today being £291 from WA and £2,049 from EA.

The biggest expense was website hosting being £2,512.80, with insurance being £474.99 and purchase of Jones Counters being £960. Costs relating to the 2022 AGM were funded retrospectively by ARC and EA each paying £459.47. I am unclear whether a similar arrangement is in place for the 2023 AGM.

A surplus for the year of £141.98 is reported which will generate a Corporation Tax liability of £28.40.
