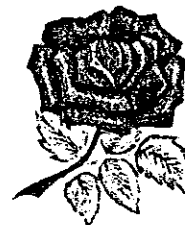

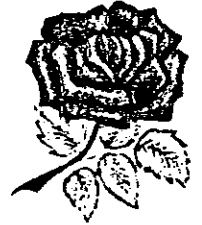
Depending how things progress we will amend the programme as necessary so as to make the most of this opportunity to 'drain' the existing 'think-tank' of UK measurement expertise.
